- I. Signs Update: Signs are being made for Easter Egg Hunt, July 4th Parade, Adult Holiday Party and Fall Festival (already made). Prototype is done. Awaiting Committee's approval.
- II. Yard Sale Recap: 84 homes participated. Advertising for the event was placed in the Chesterfield Observer, Village News, The Community Weekly, Craig's List, RTD, and RTD Online. Expenses included advertising, flyer printing, balloons and signs, and map/list printing: Total: \$186.75. Several ideas were suggested for next year.
- III. Spring Yard Contest: 11 nominations. 4 committee members judged yards on May 31st. 1st Place: The Baileys at 8225 Sidlaw Hills Terrace, 2nd Place: The Whitlocks at 8013 Lammermoor Court. Winners will be announced on the website, and winners will receive a gift certificate to the Club for \$25.00. Winners will be notified by June 4th.
- IV. Block Captain Reception: Planned for June 4th in the Castleberry Room of the Club from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. Coffee, desserts, wine and beer will be served. Two games are planned, as well as raffle drawings every 15 minutes. 30 people have RSVP'd. Reception will be paid for by the Board. Prizes: two \$25.00 gift cards to BP gas station, flashlights and LED ear lights. Block captains were invited by formal invitation, as well as an Evite to captains with e-mail addresses.
- V. July 4th Parade, planned for 10:15 a.m. on Saturday, July 4th. 100 participants last year. Participants will be judged by best bike, best pet, best kid's vehicle, best "other" vehicle, best "on foot" participant, best horse participant. All participants will have numbers, and winners will be awarded medals and gift certificates to Brusters Ice Cream (6 certificates for \$30 each). Drinks and popsicles will be provided. Budget: \$250.
- VI. Pet Day planned for September 20th, 2009 from 2-5 p.m. at the Sales Center. Activities will consist of pet adoptions from HAPPE pets, information on pet related products, donation drive for local animal shelters, a pet parade with prizes for winners, and dog washing. Email sent to pet sitters in the Highlands directory to gauge interest in dog washers. Dog washers will receive \$5 for small dog, and \$7 for large dogs, with an opportunity for pet sitters to distribute flyers or cards for their services. Many pet sitters donated their profits to participating animal shelters. Budget: \$100.
